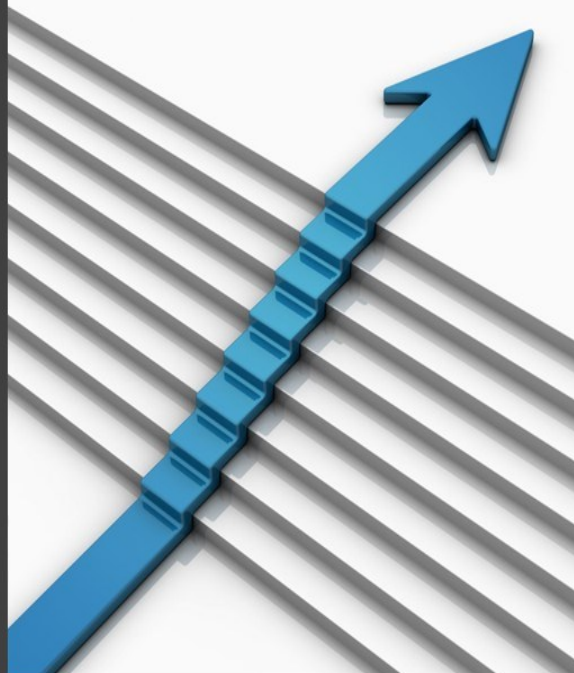

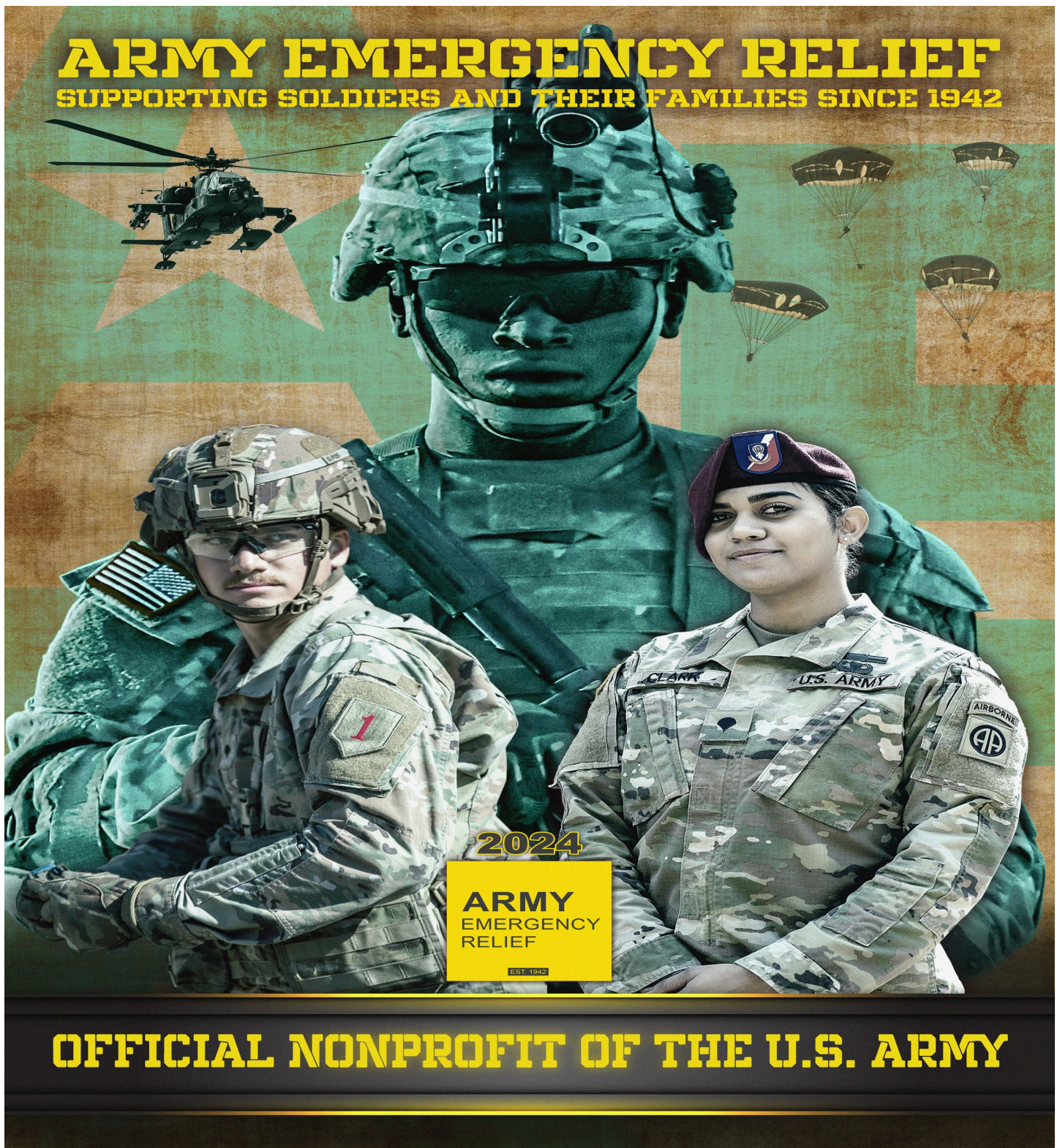

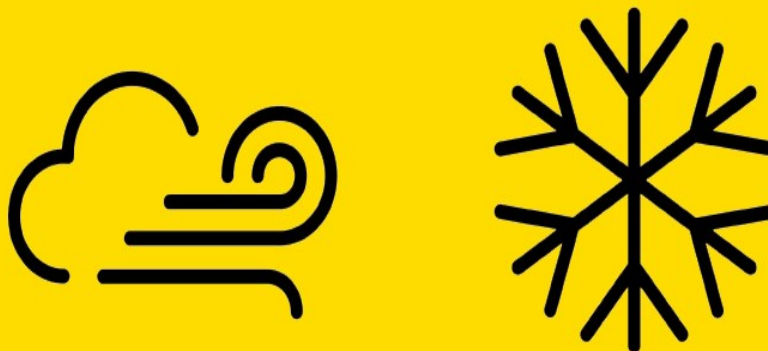


Due to delays with the FAFSA, AER will begin taking dependent children applications Feb. 1.

HOW DO I TAKE THE 2024 SURVEY?



1. Go to <https://www.armyfamilywebportal.com>
2. Click on “Calling all Military Spouses,” in the NEWS column (middle column)
3. Click the “DON’T HAVE A TICKET” button
4. Put your 10-digit **BENEFICIARY DOD ID NUMBER** found on the back of your Military ID Card. This ensures only military spouses are the ones completing the survey and they are completing it only one time. It is an anonymous survey.
5. Put in your **DAY** of birth and click the **GET MY TICKET NUMBER** button.
6. Click Start Survey
